Works notification: Works to begin on Princes Highway

We're removing the dangerous and congested level crossing at Cherry Street in Werribee by building a new road bridge, connecting Tarneit Road to Princes Highway.

We'll soon start working along Princes Highway as we begin to prepare the area for the new signalised intersection at Princes Highway and the corner of Wattle Avenue, near Wyndham City Council offices.

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Cherry Street Level Crossing Removal Project, as is supporting social distancing measures in line with current health advice.

We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.

What we're doing

From 15 June we'll start to install temporary fencing on the northern side of Princes Highway as we begin to prepare the area for the new signalised intersection.

We'll work during the day between 9.30am and 3pm and at night between 8pm and 5am to avoid traffic disruptions during peak hours. Fencing will remain in place until late 2020.

We'll also remove vegetation in this area between 19 and 24 June, to clear the area for the new signalised intersection.

We'll do this during regular construction hours, between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 3pm on Saturdays.

An aborist will be on site to inspect any vegetation for wildlife before it's removed. If any wildlife is found, the appropriate steps will be taken to protect and safely relocate.

We'll offset the vegetation we remove by replanting two trees for every tree removed at the end of the project.

What to expect

Light machinery and trucks will be visible in the area as we carry out these works.

You may notice some construction related noise and dust, however crews will take every measure to reduce impacts on nearby residents.

There will be temporary lane closures during off peak hours on Princes Highway and reduced speed limits during these works.

Traffic management will be in place to help guide motorists, pedestrians and cyclists through the area.
