Works notification: Major works continue at Cherry Street

We're removing the dangerous and congested level crossing at Cherry Street in Werribee by building a new road bridge, connecting Tarneit Road to Princes Highway.

We're making significant progress as construction continues at Cherry Street. We'll soon start working at the Railway Avenue and Tarneit Road and the Princes Highway and Wattle Avenue intersections as we prepare these areas for new signalised intersections.

The health and safety of our workers and community is our key priority as we continue works on the Cherry Street Level Crossing Removal Project. To find out more about the measures in place on our projects, visit our website. For information about coronavirus, visit coronavirus.vic.gov.au.

Throughout May, we:

- Relocated underground services near the corner of Cherry Street and Railway Avenue
- Started installing support structures for the bridge beams in the rail corridor
- Started watermain relocation works along Jellicoe Street and Jellicoe Court

Upcoming works

Throughout June, we'll:

- Continue to install support structures for the road bridge beams
- Begin piling works within the rail corridor to make way for the road bridge beams
- Install temporary fencing and barriers on the corner of Tarneit Road and Railway Avenue and on the northern side of Princes Highway near Wattle Avenue to create a safer working environment
- Remove vegetation along the northern side of Princes Highway and near the Tarneit Road and Railway
 Avenue intersection to make way for the new singalised intersections
- Install support structures for the road bridge beams
- Relocate the water main to the south of the rail line
- Continue water main relocation works on Jellicoe Court, Jellicoe Street, Railway Avenue and Tarneit Road
- Close the bus stop on Tarneit Road and Glenluss Street from 16 June until late 2020 to make way for the new signalised intersection at Railway Avenue and Tarneit Road

We'll have an aborist on site to inspect any vegetation for wildlife before it's removed. If any wildlife is found, they will take appropriate steps to protect and safely relocate the wildlife. We'll offset the vegetation we remove by replanting two trees for every tree removed at the end of the project.

What to expect

During these works, there'll be changes to the way you travel around the area. There will be temporary off-peak lane closures and reduced speeds along Cherry Street, Railway Avenue, Tarneit Road, and Princes Highway. At times, we'll have temporary pedestrian detours on Railway Avenue.

Traffic management and detour signs will help guide motorists, pedestrians and cyclists safely through the area. There will be partial road closures on Jellicoe Street and Jellicoe Court as we carry out water main relocation works.

Night works

In mid-June we'll work at night between 8pm and 5am to install fencing on Princes Highway near Wyndham City Council and at the Railway Avenue and Tarneit Road intersection, as we prepare these areas for new signalised intersections.

At times, heavy vehicles will be required to deliver materials to site after hours via Railway Avenue, Princes Highway and Cherry Street.

More information will be provided to residents that may be affected.

Buses replacing trains on the Werribee line
