Works notification: Continuing to set up site at Werribee Street

We're removing the dangerous and congested level crossing at Werribee Street in Werribee by building a new rail bridge.

We're continuing to set up our site, with construction due to begin in the coming months. This will ensure a safe and efficient work environment is created for our workers and the local community.

Throughout May, we:

- Started setting up our site compounds at various locations along the rail corridor
- Installed temporary fencing and safety barriers around the project area
- Commenced the installation of the new combined services route
- Began works to construct the temporary track for freight trains
- Relocated underground services around the project area

Upcoming works

Throughout June, we'll:

- Continue to set up our main site compounds and project area
- Locate and relocate underground services, including electricity, gas and water
- Install conduits and pits for the train signalling systems
- Widen the Princes Highway and Werribee Street intersection to make room for construction vehicle movements
- Start piling works within the rail corridor

During these works there'll be reduced speeds around the project site and temporary lane closures. Traffic management will help guide motorists, pedestrians and cyclists safely through the area.

The public car parking, pedestrian footpath, and the route 190 and 192 bus stop on the south side of Cottrell Street between Greaves and Werribee streets will remain closed throughout the project to make way for a temporary track for freight trains.

Extended work hours

Our regular construction hours are from Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and on Saturdays between 7am to 3pm. At times during June, we'll need to work outside of these hours, on Saturdays between 7pm and 5pm and on Sundays from 8am to 5pm.

If we need to work outside of our regular hours, we'll let nearby residents and businesses know in advance.

Night works

Due to Metro Trains maintenance works, buses will replace trains from 9pm Friday 12 June to last train Sunday 14 June between Newport, Werribee and Williamstown stations.

During this time we'll also work continuously within the rail corridor from 9pm on Friday 12 June until 4am Monday 15 June, to complete piling works.

You may notice some construction related noise and vibration, however crews will take every measure to reduce impacts on nearby residents.
