## Works shaping up in Werribee

Works are progressing well in the west.

We'll be working around the clock on the Werribee line at both Werribee Street and Cherry Street from **Sunday 29 November** to **last service Sunday 6 December**.

During this time, [buses will replace trains between Laverton and Werribee stations](#).

### Cherry Street

Throughout November, we'll continue to upgrade the intersections at Tarneit Road and Railway Avenue, and Princes Highway and Wattle Avenue and we'll extend the right turning lane from Princes Highway onto Cherry Street.

### Werribee Street

The [Werribee Street rail bridge is taking shape](#), with the large concrete bridge beams now lifted into place over the road.

Throughout November, we'll continue working around the clock to install the remaining bridge beams. We'll also start laying the new rail track across the bridge in late November.

## Changes to the way you travel

Upcoming changes to the way you travel throughout late October and November include:

### Road

- Intermittent lane closures and reduced speeds on Princes Highway, Werribee Street, Cottrell Street and Bulban Road
- Intermittent lane closures and reduced speeds on Cherry Street, Princes Highway, Wattle Avenue, Tarneit Road and Railway Avenue
- Intermittent closures on Cherry Street for up to five minutes between **Sunday 29 November and Tuesday 1 December**

- Left turn movements only from Wattle Avenue onto Princes Highway until late November while we work to upgrade and signalise the intersection
- [Bus route 443](#) and [bus route 153](#) will not service selected bus stops till 20 November. To plan your journey at [ptv.vic.gov.au](http://ptv.vic.gov.au) or call 1800 800 007.

## Rail

- [Buses replace trains on the Werribee line between Laverton and Werribee](#) from **8.30pm Sunday 29 November to last service Sunday 6 December**.

## Pedestrian and cycling

- Sections of the cycling path on Princes Highway will be closed intermittently throughout November.

## Works continue this spring

Victoria's Big Build continues in spring as we work to remove some of Melbourne's most dangerous and congested level crossings on the Upfield, Frankston and Cranbourne lines. We're also upgrading the Sunbury Line and continuing underground works on the Metro Tunnel.

Over the next few months, you'll see early works continue on Victoria's biggest road project, North East Link. Road works ramp up across the state with works continuing on the new Mordialloc Freeway, as well as upgrades to the West Gate Freeway and Monash Freeway.
