
Pedestrian and cyclist underpass now open

The dangerous and congested Werribee Street and Cherry Street level crossings are gone for good, making central Werribee completely level crossing free.

The new pedestrian and cyclist underpass near the former Cherry Street level crossing site is also now open.

The well-lit, wide underpass safely connects pedestrians and cyclists to either side of the rail line.

Works in and around the underpass will continue in the coming weeks and months and public art is currently being installed.



Werribee Street resurfaced and now open

Last month, crews worked around the clock to remove the old rail track at the former Werribee Street level crossing and resurface the intersection.

Under the Werribee Street rail bridge, we'll be building a new skate park and planting thousands of trees and shrubs.

Upcoming night works in April

We'll continue work to remove the Railway Avenue and Market Road roundabout, connect the two roads and install pedestrian signals until May.

The intersection is closed until May and drivers can detour via Shaws Road, Tarneit Road and over the new road bridge.

From **Thursday 29 April to Friday 7 May**, we'll work at night at the former Cherry Street level crossing to remove old road and track infrastructure.
