Goodbye Cherry Street level crossing, hello new road bridge

We've removed the Cherry Street level crossing and the new bridge is now open, directly connecting Tarneit Road to Princes Highway.

The Cherry Street crossing is the 46th to go, making central Werribee completely level crossing free.

More than 20,000 vehicles travelled through the Cherry Street level crossing each day, often held up by boom gates, which were down for up to a third of the morning peak.

With the new road bridge now open, travel times are more predictable, and safety improved for the community and surrounding suburbs.

Major construction will continue at Cherry Street as we work on the pedestrian and cyclist underpass and nearby roads.

Werribee Street update

With boom gates gone and trains now travelling over the Werribee Street rail bridge, we're resurfacing the former level crossing at Werribee Street.

This month we'll continue installing new roadside curbing and barriers, and creating the new open space under the bridge.

Changes to the way you travel

- [Werribee Street](#) day and night lane closures at times until **Friday 19 March**.
- [Werribee Street closed between Cottrell Street and Princes Highway](#) from **Friday 19 March to Saturday 27 March**.
- [Princes Highway reduced to one lane](#) until **mid April 2021**.
- [Princes Highway near Werribee Street](#), reduced speeds until **Saturday 20 March**.
- [Market Road, Werribee](#) closed at the Market Road and Railway Avenue intersection from **Monday 29 March to Monday 31 May**.
